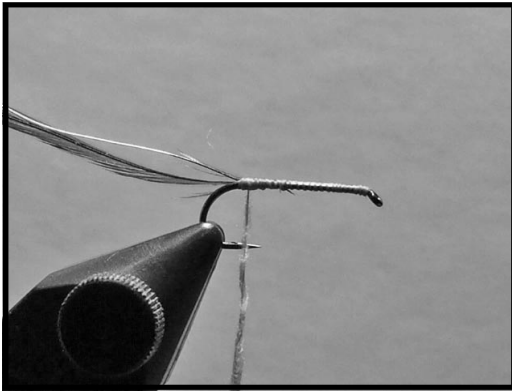


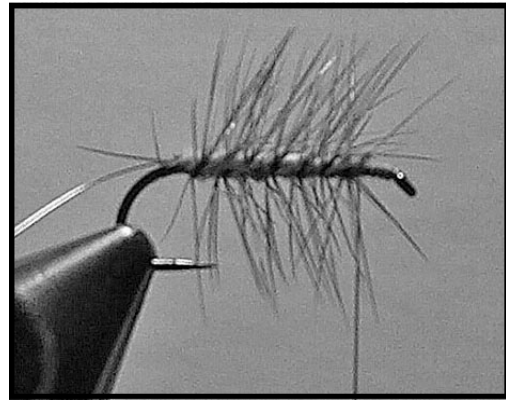
# Elk Hair Caddis

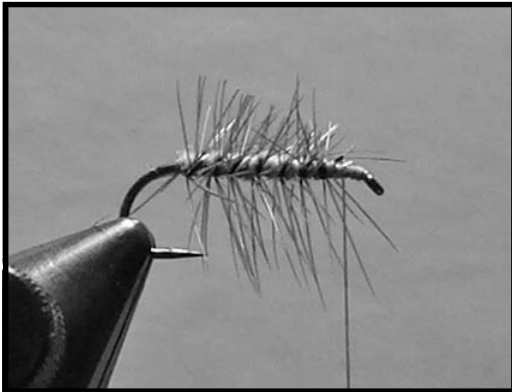

|--------|----------------------------------|
| Hook:  | Standard dry fly hook, size 8-18 |
| Thread | Tan or Brown 3/0 or 6/0          |
| Rib    | Fine gold wire                   |
| Body   | Tan dubbing                      |
| Hackle | Brown neck hackle                |
| Wing   | Elk hair                         |



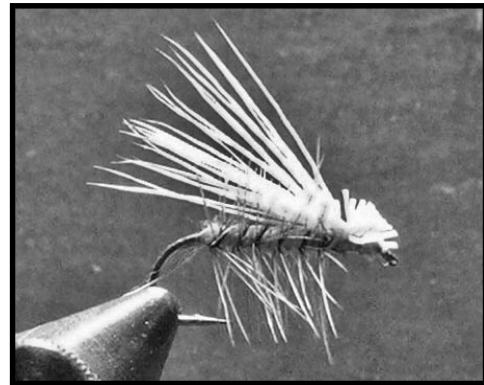
Step 1: Start the thread on the hook and wrap back to the bend. Tie in the gold wire rib, then tie in one brown neck hackle



Step 2: Add dubbing to the thread and wrap forward to about 1/8" to 1/16th" behind the eye depending on the hook size. The palmer the hackle forward and tie off.



Step 3: trim the hackle at an angle to match the angle of the wing, then counter wrap the wire through the hackle and tie off.



Step 4: Select and stack an appropriate amount of elk hair and tie in so that the ends of the hair extend just beyond the bend of the hook. Trim the butt ends of the Elk hair at a 45 degree angle to form a head. Whip finish and cement.
