

He is a frequent contributor to fishing publications, and pioneered fly fishing video instruction. Gary was a consultant on the movie "A River Runs Through It". He is a founding member of Fly Fishing International's fly casting instructor certification program, and a member of Trout Unlimited and other conservation organizations.

Dale Collins is a guide and co-owner of Tuckaseegee Fly Shops in Bryson City and Sylva, NC.
