
## **Black Stone Fly On English Bait Hook** By: Don Privett


Hook: Mustad 37160 Thread: black 6/0 Weight: .015" lead Tail: 2 black Goose biots

Rib: black ultrawire Body: UV Black Ice Dub Thorax: Same ice dub as body, picked out Wingcase: Goose wing feather


1. Start the thread behind the eye and wrap to hook point. Then wrap .015" lead from behind eye to hook point. Overwrap with thread and build a small ball behind lead...



3. Apply dubbing to thread and wrap body forward. Then counterwrap wire rib forward and tie off behind the eye of the hook.



2. Tie in 2 black Goose biots for the tail using the thread ball described in step 1 to hold the biots apart to form the split tail.



4. Dub thorax and tie in Goose wing feather to form wing case. Build a large thread head and whip finish.
