
Hi-Vis Spinner By: Don Privett

Hook – Tiemco 100 sizes 10 - 22 Thread – 8/0 color to match body Tail - Micro fibetts Body – Fine dubbing, choice of colors Wing - Float-Vis white or dun


- 1. Start the thread at the eye and wind back to hook bend.
- 2. Form a small ball of dubbing at the bend of the hook to help divide the tail.




3. Tie in 3 or 4

bing and position them to form a wide V.

- 4. Form a sparse body of dubbing to cover 3/4 of the hook shank.
- 5. Tie in the Float-Vis wing and secure with figure 8 wraps.



6. Add dubbing to cover wraps around and in front of the wing, and whip finish.



This is a versatile fly that can imitate most spinners simply by varying the color of the materials.
