
March Brown Nymph



Hook: Thread Tail: Rib: Body: Wing case: Thorax: TMC 3671 1X long Size 10 – 12 6/0 Brown Pheasant tail fibers Brown thread or fine brown wire March Brown dubbing Dark Turkey Same as Body


Step 1. Start the thread behind the eye and wrap back the shank of the hook to the bend. There tie in 5 or 6 Pheasant tail fibers.



Step 3. With the thread at the bend of the hook tie in the Brown wire or thread rib and dub the body up to about $\frac{1}{2}$ the distance to the hook eye. Wrap the rib forward with wide wraps to give a segmented look. Tie in the Turkey wing shiny side down with the long end pointing back over the tail of the hook.



Step 2. To give the correct flat body shape of this nymph tie in .020 lead wire, one piece on each side of the hook shank.



Step 4 Dub the thorax so that it is a bit bulkier than the body. Then fold the Turkey wing forward over the Thorax to form the wing case. Build a head and whip finish.
