Murray's Helgramite



Step 1: Wrap 10 to 15 turns of the lead and tie in 14 to 16 strands of the Ostrich Herl. Cut the herl approximately 2x the hook length.



Step 3: Wrap the chenille forward and tie down.

This is a good pattern for smallmouth in the Northern Indiana Rivers. Fish it like you would a Woolly Bugger. Hook:#4-#6 Mustad 9672, TMC 5263Thread:6/0 BlackBody:Black ChenilleLead:.025Tail:Black Ostritch HerlPinchers:Medium Black RubberHackle:Black and Webby



Step 2: Tie a pair of black rubber pinchers behind the eye of the hook. Tie the chenille, then hackle at the back of the hook.



Step 4: Wrap the hackle forward and tie down. Add 2 to three turns of thread under the pinchers to raise. Separate the rubber pair to form a V. Apply head cement and go fishing.
