


Pheasant Tail Nymph


	Material lists
Hook:	3671 size 10-20
Thread	Brown 6/0
Rib	Small copper wire
Tail	Pheasant tail fibers
Abdomen	Pheasant tail fibers
Thorax	Peacock Herl
Wingcase and legs	Pheasant tail fibers
Weight (optional)	Lead wire




Step 1: wrap 10-12 turns of lead on front part of shank if desired. Start thread and wrap back to bend of hook. Tie in 4-5 Pheasant tail fibers for the tail. Tie in the copper wire rib, then tie in a bunch (10-12) Pheasant tail fiber.



Step 2: move the thread forward to the Thorax and wrap the bunch of Pheasant tail fibers forward to the thorax. Counter wrap the copper wire rib over the body. Secure and trim. Tie in another bunch of 8-10 Pheasant tail fibers for the wingcase and legs.



Step 3: Tie in 3 or 4 Peacock herl fibers and wrap forward to form the Thorax and tie off. Then pull the Pheasant tail fibers forward over the Thorax to form the wingcase.



Step 4: Pull the tips of the Pheasant tail fibers that form the wingcase down and back to form the legs. Form a thread head and whip finish.
