## **Rubber Legged Seducer**

Hook sz. 10-18 3xlong dry fly hook

Thread 6/0 Olive

Body Black fine dubbing

Wing Deer hair

Legs Small olive rubber

Hackle Light Dun

Thorax Light olive fine dubbing



Step 1: Start thread and wrap back to bend of hook. Dub the thread and form body on rear 2/3 of the hook. Tie in the wind of deer hair so that it is about the same length as the hook.



Step 3: Wrap the hackle forward with two turns between the legs and 3 or 4 turns in front of the legs over the thorax. Finish with half-hitches or whip finish. Fish this fly as a Hopper, Caddis, Stonefly, or use as an indicator fly when using a dropper.



Step 2: Tie in two rubber legs and separate into X-shape. Tie in one hackle feather between legs, then dub the thread and form the thorax. Leave room behind the eye to tie off the hackle and form a head.
