Members Favorite Fly's



Black Mamba 10-13-12 by Curly Hodson

Hook: TMC 300, #2-4

Thread: Uni-Thread, Black, 6/0

Tail: Marabou, Black

Under Body: Marabou, Black Over Tail: Rabbit Strip, Black

Tail Flash: Flashabou, Blue (10), Purple (13), Black (12) (4 strands each)

Body: Pearl Chenille, Black, Medium

Hackle: Schlappen, Black

Collar: Hackle, Pheasant Rump, Black

High Dirty Water (swing or strip)

Instructions:

Lay down a base layer of thread.

Tie in the marabou tail (length of the shank); tie in marabou on top of the hook to 1/4" from the eye for body bulk. Tie in the rabbit strip at the tie in point of the tail, length should be hook shank plus a 1/4".

Tie in the Flashabou at the tie in point of the tail on each side of the tail as long as the tail and parallel to the shank.

Tie in the schlappen by the tip at the tie in point of the tail.

Tie in the chenille 1/4" in front of the tie in point of the schlappen and tie in back to the original tie in point.

Wrap the chenille forward to within 1/4" of the eye, tie off.

Palmer the schlappen forward to the front of the chenille, tie off.

Tie in the pheasant rump hackle by the tip in front of the schlappen.

Make 3-5 wraps without fluff, soft hackle style leaving space behind the eye for the head.

Tie a nice size tapered thread head.

Glue for durability and sheen.

I tie this in different colors.

I also tie this with variations of colors of Flashabou.

Boog's Bug Jamie Thompson



Hook: Dry Fly, #10-#12 Thread: Black, 8/0

Weight: Lead Wire, (wrapped from hook point to three eye lengths behind eye)

Tail: Hen Hackle Fibers, Black, 10-12, (one hook gap in length)

Body: Chenille, Black, Medium, (wrapped to where lead wire ends)

Hackle: Hen Hackle, Black (3-4 wraps)

Simple to tie; but, very effective. Fish with a long leader. Fly will sink slowly and many bites occur while it is sinking.
